Petro Chrypko Memorial Award

The Manitoba Parents for Ukrainian Education Inc. (MPUE) and the ***Petro Chrypko Memorial Award*** offers five \$100.00 awards to five students who will be completing high school. This award is financially supported by the Osvita Foundation Inc.

Purpose of the Award:

The Manitoba Parents for Ukrainian Education Inc. and ***Petro Chrypko Memorial Award*** recognizes graduating students who have combined academic excellence and involvement in the Ukrainian community.

Application Requirements:

1. The competition is open to all former English Ukrainian Bilingual Program (EUBP) students residing in Manitoba who have received an S4 credit for Ukrainian language obtained through a special language credit option exam offered by Manitoba Education, Citizenship and Youth, a correspondence course, or a recognized summer program.
2. A final S3 academic transcript must be provided together with at least a third term standing in S4. An official copy of a final S4 transcript must be forwarded as soon as it becomes available.
3. Applicants should provide a brief outline of their extra curricular and community involvement.
4. Applicants must have successfully completed the highest level of the English Ukrainian Bilingual Program offered in their school division.
5. Applicants must provide three (3) letters of reference from non-family members, example:
 - a. Educator,
 - b. Community/Church leader

Selection process:

Candidates will be selected based on the above listed criteria by the Manitoba Parents for Ukrainian Education Scholarship Selection Committee.

All applications for the *Petro Chrypko Memorial Awards* must be submitted to MPUE by July 15, 2009 at 4:00pm.

- Late applications will not be considered.
- Recipients will be requested to participate in an Osvita Foundation Inc. event (at no cost to the student) during the following year, providing an opportunity for the community to recognize each of the students.
- Recipients are also invited to apply for the ***Petro Chrypko Memorial Award*** of \$500 offered to graduating students. Please contact MPUE for more information.
